

Day 12 – The God that Serve’s

Morning

Philippians 2:5-8 (NLT)

⁵ You must have the same attitude that Christ Jesus had. ⁶ Though he was God, he did not think of equality with God as something to cling to. ⁷ Instead, he gave up his divine privileges; he took the humble position of a slave and was born as a human being. When he appeared in human form,

⁸ he humbled himself in obedience to God and died a criminal’s death on a cross.

Mark 10:42-45 (NLT)

⁴² So Jesus called them together and said, “You know that the rulers in this world lord it over their people, and officials flaunt their authority over those under them. ⁴³ But among you it will be different. Whoever wants to be a leader among you must be your servant, ⁴⁴ and whoever wants to be first among you must be the slave of everyone else. ⁴⁵ For even the Son of Man came not to be served but to serve others and to give his life as a ransom for many.”

Prayer

Praise Jesus for His humble desire to sacrifice and serve.

Afternoon

Matthew 23:11-12 (NLT)

¹¹ The greatest among you must be a servant. ¹² But those who exalt themselves will be humbled, and those who humble themselves will be exalted.

1 Peter 5:5b-7 (NLT)

^{5b} and all of you, dress yourselves in humility as you relate to one another, for “God opposes the proud but gives grace to the humble.” ⁶ So humble yourselves under the mighty power of God, and at the right time he will lift you up in honour. ⁷ Give all your worries and cares to God, for he cares about you.

Prayer

Ask God to reveal to you an area where He wants you to serve. Ask Him to help you imitate His ways.
